

Nature Passport App Terms of Use

These Terms of Use are applicable to your access to and use of the Nature Passport App mobile application including the software contained in the mobile application (“Software”) and the associated website (collectively the “Nature Passport App”) operated by or on behalf of IslandWood and Nature Play (“we”, “us”, or “our”). **By using the Nature Passport App, and allowing your children to use the Nature Passport App, you agree on behalf of yourself and your children to follow and be bound by the policies and rules set forth below.** “You” and “Your” includes both you and your children for the purposes of these Terms of Use.

Your access to and use of the Nature Passport App and the information, materials, products, and services available through the Nature Passport App are subject to these Terms of Use. Please read these Terms of Use carefully before using the Nature Passport App. If you do not understand or agree to be bound by these Terms of Use, do not access or use the Nature Passport App.

CHANGES TO THESE TERMS OF USE

We reserve the right to modify these Terms of Use, in whole or in part, at our own discretion at any time. Modifications shall be effective immediately upon the linking of modified Terms of Use to the Nature Passport App. You agree to comply with, and be bound by, any such modifications by continuing to use or access the Nature Passport App after modified Terms of Use are posted to the Nature Passport App.

PRIVACY POLICY

REVISIONS TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY

ANY INFORMATION THAT IS COLLECTED VIA OUR SERVICES IS COVERED BY THE PRIVACY POLICY IN EFFECT AT THE TIME SUCH INFORMATION IS COLLECTED. WE MAY REVISE THIS PRIVACY POLICY FROM TIME TO TIME. IF WE MAKE ANY MATERIAL CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY, INCLUDING ANY CHANGE THAT WE PROPOSE THAT WILL HAVE RETROACTIVE EFFECT, WE'LL NOTIFY YOU OF THOSE CHANGES BY POSTING THEM ON THE SERVICES OR BY SENDING YOU AN EMAIL OR OTHER NOTIFICATION AND INVITE YOU TO ACCEPT OUR REVISED PRIVACY POLICY, AND WE'LL UPDATE THE "LAST UPDATED DATE" ABOVE TO INDICATE WHEN THOSE CHANGES WERE MADE. COLLECTION AND USE OF INFORMATION

No Account Needed. The Nature Passport App does not involve creating an account or collecting any data or information that can be used to identify you (or your authorized child) (together, "**Personal Data**").

Information Related to Use of the Services. Our servers automatically record certain information about how a person uses our Services (we refer to this information as "**Log Data**"). Log Data may include information such as browser type, operating system, the web page that a User was visiting before accessing our Services, the pages or features of our Services to which a User browsed and the time spent on those pages or features, search terms, the links on our Services that a User clicked on, and other statistics. We use Log Data to administer the Services and we analyze (and may engage third parties to analyze) Log Data to improve, customize, and enhance our Services by expanding their features and functionality and tailoring them to our Users' needs and preferences. We may use a person's Log Data and other information to generate aggregate, non-identifying information about how our Services are used and use such aggregated information to understand and improve our Services and to administer use of the Services.

Information Sent by Your Mobile Device. We collect certain information that your (or your authorized child's) mobile device sends when you (or your authorized child) use our Services, like a device identifier, user settings, and the operating system of your (or your authorized child's) device, as well as information about your use of our Services while using the mobile device. We may use this information to provide the Services and to improve and personalize our Services for you (or your authorized child).

INFORMATION THAT WE SHARE WITH THIRD PARTIES

We will not share any information that we have collected from or regarding you (or your authorized child) except as described below:

Information Shared with Third Parties. We may share aggregated information and non-identifying information with third parties for research and analysis, demographic profiling, and other similar purposes.

Information Disclosed for Our Protection and the Protection of Others. We cooperate with government and law enforcement officials or private parties to enforce and comply with the law. We may disclose any information about you (or your authorized child) that is in our possession or control to government or law enforcement officials or private parties as we, in our sole discretion, believe necessary or appropriate: (a) to respond to claims, legal process (including subpoenas); (b) to protect our property, rights, and safety and the property, rights, and safety of a third party or the public in general; and (c) to identify and stop any activity that we consider illegal, unethical, or legally actionable activity.

LINKS TO OTHER SITES

Our Services may contain links to websites and services that are owned or operated by third parties (each, a “**Third Party Service**”). Any information that you (or your authorized child) provide on or to a Third Party Service or that is collected by a Third Party Service is provided directly to the owner or operator of the Third Party Service and is subject to the owner’s or operator’s privacy policy. We’re not responsible for the content, privacy, or security practices and policies of any Third Party Service. To protect your (or your authorized child’s) information we recommend that you carefully review the privacy policies of all Third Party Service that you (or your authorized child) access via our Services.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

This limitation of liability (“Limitation”) applies to your free use of the Nature Passport App. Your use of the Nature Passport App is at your own risk. You acknowledge that you and your child/children’s participation is voluntarily in the Nature Passport App activities on your own initiative, and at your own risk. You waive any and all claim, right or cause of action which might otherwise have arisen out of injury, damage or loss of any description whatsoever sustained in the course participating in the Nature Passport App activities.

Except as prohibited by applicable law, in no event will IslandWood, Nature Play or any of their respective officers, directors, employees, shareholders, affiliates, agents, successors or assigns, nor any party involved in the creation, production or transmission of the Nature Passport App, be liable to you or anyone else for any indirect, special, punitive, incidental or consequential damages (including, without limitation, those resulting from lost profits, lost data or business interruption) arising out of the use, inability to use, or the results of use of the Nature Passport App, any Apps linked to the Nature Passport App, and its Content, whether based on warranty, contract, tort or any other legal theory and whether or not advised of the possibility of such damages. You may not modify any of the materials and you may not copy, distribute, transmit, display, perform, reproduce, publish, license, create derivative works from, transfer, or sell any information or work contained on the Nature Passport App. Except as authorized under the copyright laws, you are responsible for obtaining permission before reusing any copyrighted material that is available on the Nature Passport App. You shall comply with all applicable domestic and international laws, statutes, ordinances, and regulations regarding your use of the Nature Passport App. The Nature Passport App, its Content, and all related rights shall remain the exclusive property of IslandWood, Nature Play or our licensors unless otherwise expressly agreed. You will not remove any copyright, trademark, or other proprietary notices from material found on the Nature Passport App.

TRADEMARKS

All trademarks, service marks, and trade names used herein (collectively "Marks") are trademarks or registered trademarks of the IslandWood, Nature Play, or our affiliates, partners, vendors, or licensors. You may not use, copy, reproduce, republish, upload, post, transmit, distribute, or modify the Marks in any way without our prior written consent.

SOFTWARE

We are providing the Software to you pursuant to the following terms. We grant you a non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited license to use the Software solely in conjunction with the operation of the Nature Passport App. Except as specifically provided herein, You may not, in whole or in part: (a) copy the Software, (b) distribute copies of the Software, in whole or in part, to any third party; (c) modify, adapt, translate, reverse engineer, make alterations, decompile, disassemble or make derivative works based on the Software, except as otherwise permitted by law; (d) use, rent, loan, sub-license, lease, distribute or attempt to grant other rights to the Software to third parties; or (e) use the Software to act as a service bureau or application service provider, or to permit access to the Software by any third party.

ACCURACY OF INFORMATION

We attempt to ensure that information on the Nature Passport App is complete, accurate, and current. Despite our efforts, the information on the Nature Passport App may occasionally be inaccurate, incomplete, or out of date. We make no representation as to the completeness, accuracy, or currency of any information on the Nature Passport App. You acknowledge that we have no duty or obligation to maintain the accuracy of, or update any such information, and agree that your reliance on any such information is at your own risk.

YOUR CONDUCT

You agree to comply with all laws, rules, and regulations applicable to your access to and use of the Nature Passport App. In addition, you agree not to:

FORCE MAJEURE

Neither IslandWood or Nature Play, nor any of their respective affiliates, warrants that the functions contained in the Nature Passport App will be uninterrupted or error-free, that defects will be corrected, or that the server that makes the content available will be free of viruses or other harmful components.

INDEMNIFICATION

Except as prohibited by applicable law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold us, our affiliates, subsidiaries, joint ventures, third-party service providers, and our respective employees, contractors, agents, officers, and directors harmless from all liabilities, claims, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) that arise out of or are related to any User-Provided Content you upload, post, transmit, publish, display, or otherwise make available through the Nature Passport App, your violation of these Terms of Use, your use or misuse of the Nature Passport App, or your violation of any third-party rights.\

RELEASE

In the event that you have a dispute with one or more other users of the Nature Passport App, you release IslandWood and Nature Play (and their officers, directors, agents, subsidiaries, joint ventures and employees) from claims, demands, and damages (actual and consequential) of every kind and nature, known and unknown, suspected and unsuspected, disclosed and undisclosed, arising out of or in any way connected with such disputes.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION – ARBITRATION, JURY TRIAL WAIVER

Neither you nor we will be able to sue in court in connection with dispute. All disputes must be resolved through individual (non-class) arbitration. You indicate your acceptance to these Terms of Use, including this agreement to arbitrate, by continuing to use the Nature Passport App after having the opportunity to review these Terms of Use.

Instead of suing in court, we each agree to settle disputes only by arbitration. The rules in arbitration are different. There’s no judge or jury, and review is limited, but an arbitrator can award the same damages and relief, and must honor the same limitations stated in the agreement as a court would.

EQUITABLE RELIEF

You acknowledge that any breach or threatened breach of these Terms of Use will result in irreparable harm for which damages would not be an adequate remedy, and, therefore, in addition to our rights and remedies otherwise available at law, we shall be entitled to immediate equitable relief, including injunctive relief, as appropriate. If we seek any equitable remedies, we shall not be precluded or prevented from seeking remedies at law, nor shall we be deemed to have made an election of remedies.

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of these Terms of Use is held unenforceable or invalid under any applicable law or is so held by an applicable court decision, such unenforceability or invalidity will not render these Terms of Use unenforceable or invalid as a whole, and such provision will be changed and interpreted so as to best accomplish the objectives of such unenforceable or invalid provision within the limits of applicable law or the applicable court decisions.

WAIVER

Any waiver by us of a breach of any provision of these Terms of Use shall not operate as or be construed to be a waiver of any other breach of such provision or of any breach of any other provision of these Terms of Use. Any such waiver must be in writing. Failure by us to insist upon strict adherence to any term of these Terms of Use on one or more occasions shall not be considered a waiver or deprive us of the right to insist upon strict adherence to that term or any other term of these Terms of Use in the future.

UNITED STATES DIGITAL MILLENNIUM COPYRIGHT ACT ("DMCA") NOTICE
